Notes:

1. Standard error is an estimate of the margin of error associated with a sample survey. The coefficient of variation (CV) indicates the robustness of each estimate. It is defined as:

$$\% = \frac{\text{standard error}}{\text{estimate}} \times 100$$

2. Cl+/- is the upper(+) and lower(-) 95% confidence limits. It is defined as:

$$1.96 \times \text{standard error}$$

3. Estimates are based on the Annual Population Survey (APS) which is the Labour Force Survey (LFS) plus various sample boosts. APS estimates have now been grossed to 2008-based population estimates and projections. Tables published from the year ending September 2009 have been revised to these estimates. Tables published prior to this were weighted using the 2006-based estimates and projections and have not been revised. There is no discernable discontinuity in these tables.

4. It should be noted that the LFS:

- * excludes students in halls who do not have a UK resident parent
- * excludes people in most other types of communal establishments (eg hotels, boarding houses, hostels, mobile home sites, etc)
- * is grossed to population estimates of those living in private households that only include migrants staying for 12 months or more. An adjustment is made for those living in institutions.

5. The LFS weighting does not adjust for non-response bias by the country of birth variable.

6. County Durham UA comprises the former Durham county.

7. Northumberland UA comprises the former Northumberland county.

8. Cheshire East UA comprises part of the former Cheshire county (Congleton, Crewe and Nantwich and Macclesfield districts).

9. Cheshire West and Chester UA comprises part of the former Cheshire county (Chester, Ellesmere Port & Neston and Vale Royal districts).

10. The former county of Cheshire is the area covered by the current unitary authorities of Cheshire East and Cheshire West and Chester.

11. Shropshire UA comprises the former Shropshire county.

12. Bedford UA comprises part of the former Bedfordshire county (Bedford district).

13. Central Bedfordshire UA comprises part of the former Bedfordshire county (Mid Bedfordshire and South Bedfordshire districts).

14. The former county of Bedfordshire is the area covered by the unitary authorities of Bedford and Central Bedfordshire created on 1 April 2009.

15. Cornwall UA comprises the former Cornwall and Isles of Scilly county excluding Isles of Scilly district. The Isles of Scilly were recoded on 1 April 2009. They are separately administered by an Isles of Scilly council and do not form part of Cornwall UA. For the purposes of protecting confidentiality, the data have been combined.

16. Wiltshire UA comprises the former Wiltshire county.

17. Non-British consists of all other nationalities except British, apart from Northern Ireland where it consists of all other nationalities except British and Irish. People born in Northern Ireland have the right to British and/or Irish nationality. Therefore in this nationality table, British and Irish nationalities have been combined for Northern Ireland, and this estimate has been placed in the British column.

18. EU26 consists of Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Republic of Ireland, Spain, Sweden, Czech Republic, Estonia, Poland, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Malta, Cyprus, Bulgaria and Romania. The United Kingdom is not included in this group, but is shown separately in this table.
